Patrons without proper current identification may be temporarily registered.

Minors who have not obtained a parent's signature may be temporarily registered.

Temporary residents in the library district (such as seasonal campground residents, occasional workers, or the like) may be temporarily registered.

Residents of shelters (such as WomanSafe) or other temporary housing facilities may be temporarily registered.

Temporarily registered patrons are generally permitted only one transaction with a maximum of two items borrowed. No more items may be borrowed until the application form is complete with proper identification or the application of the minor has been completed with the signature of a parent or guardian. Temporary residents and residents of shelters may use their temporary card to check out 2 items at a time for each library visit during the length of their stay provided they have no materials overdue and owe no fines.
